**To clarify from yesterday's memo – There are no changes to our usual procedures until Monday, July 6 at 9:00 am.**

Good hygiene – starts with good mask cleaning and frequent hand washing with soap and water.

Visitor Guidelines – Beginning Monday, July 6 visitors may come to independent living apartments. Please use the following guidelines:

- As we start opening to visitors again, please limit visitors to a two or three at a time, not entire large families. Young adult grandchildren are especially risky visitors because data tells us many have not been social distancing.
- Visitors must arrive with masks. They will be turned away if they arrive without a mask.
- Screening questions will be asked and temperatures taken at the Meadow Entrance after which visitors may proceed directly to the apartment.
- Visitors should not come to campus if they have been to any of the current "hotspots" within the last 14 days which are now: Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas and Utah.
- Visitors may not enter the Community Building.
- Everyone should wear a mask while visiting in the apartment and take the mask down only to drink/eat.

Masks – It is now mandatory to wear a mask in all settings per the Governor of PA as issued today

- Disposable masks should be changed every so often. (over)
- Cloth masks should be washed with your laundry or by hand with hot water and detergent then dried.
- Remember to wear your mask over mouth and nose.
- Wear a mask anytime you are outside your apartment or have a visitor.

Parking Permits – Beginning Monday, July 6 parking decals permit access through the Meadow Entrance past the check point in the right hand lane without stopping. Please slow down as you drive through. Parking permits are not transferrable to family; they are only for cars that live on the Pennswood campus.

Change to Gym Appointments – Beginning Monday, July 6, the gym will take up to 6 appointments per hour. Each appointment will be limited to one hour. Please exit the gym after your hour to be kind to the people scheduled next; in other words please no socializing. The gym remains only for resident use at this time.
